

CRISP DC Reporting Services Available Reports for Hospital Users

What is CRISP DC Reporting Services?

CRISP DC Reporting Services (DC CRS) is a secure web-based analytics tool enabling health care organizations to identify trends and provide insight into improving patient care throughout the District.

The DC CRS Portal enables population-level and panel-level management through clinical and administrative data and is designed with a diverse group of DC HIE users in mind to support their analyses and interventions. Currently, the reports are primarily based on Medicaid claims data, but efforts are underway to leverage clinical data flowing through the DC HIE from multiple sources, such as labs.



DC CRS links multiple data sources to offer a unique perspective on readmission rates, the total cost of care, and other critical measures to support hospitals, ambulatory providers, and public health organizations. The goal is to assist users in planning and developing care coordination efforts targeting specific conditions and beneficiaries.

Benefits of Accessing DC CRS

- Access to **visualization tools** to strengthen and facilitate **coordination across clinical and non-clinical care teams**
- View high-level demographic and utilization data to determine the **top diagnoses** and **high-cost members** for high quality care coordination and ability to **monitor progress on nationally recognized quality measures**
- Stratify and/or compare reports to **drill-down** to individual patients to **discover patterns and trends** based on high utilization, chronic disease indicators, DRG grouping, diagnoses, procedures, or other groupings
- **View overall healthcare utilization** of your patients by cost in different claim types
