The source of the data is the District of Columbia Hospital Association's Monthly Utilization Survey (self-reported by individual facilities).

Please note, though not annotated on every graphic, the impact of the closure of Providence Hospital – Ascension in the Spring of 2019 and the COVID-19 pandemic beginning in the Spring of 2020 can be seen in utilization patterns throughout this report.





Note: ED visits saw a significant decrease from 2019 to 2020 due to COVID-19. A generalized decrease in volumes is noted as 5 out of the 7 acute care hospitals saw a decline in total ED volumes going from 2023 to 2024.

Note: Calculations are based on reported utilization figures for the District of Columbia acute non-federal hospitals. The decrease in ED visits in 2019 is primarily related to the closure of Providence Hospital and their associated ED, and the decrease in 2020 is primarily attributed to the impact of COVID-19. Although volumes in 2021 to 2023 continued to rise as the impact of COVID-19 is starting to wane, a slight decline is observed in 2024 and overall volumes remain below the pre-COVID-19 levels.


