ABOUT THIS REPORT

The charts and tables in this publication are intended to provide aggregate and comparative data on health care facility utilization in the District of Columbia. The source of the data is the District of Columbia Hospital Association's Monthly Utilization Survey self-reported by individual facilities.

Please note, though not annotated on every graphic, the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic beginning in the Spring of 2020, and the combined closing of United Medical Center and opening of Cedar Hill Regional Medical Center GW Health in April 2025 can be seen in utilization patterns throughout this report.

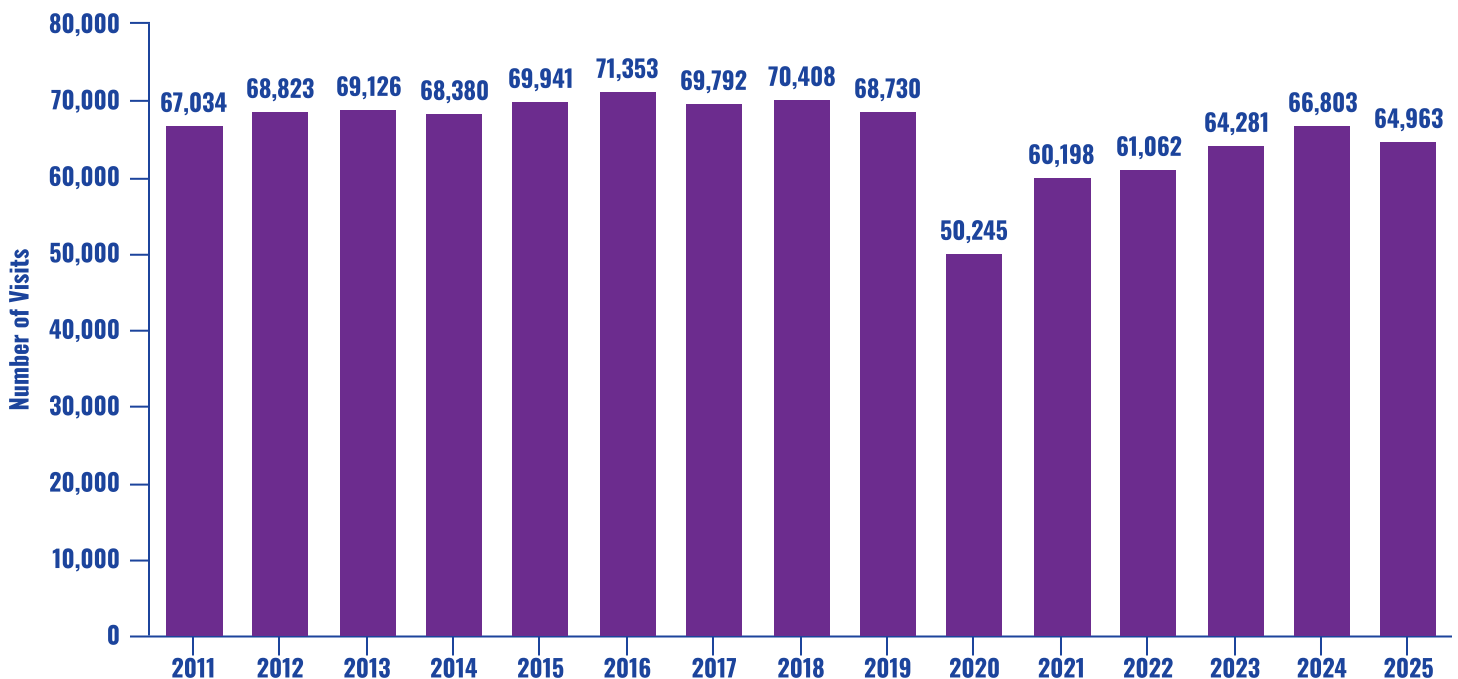

Ambulatory Surgery - Past 15 Years



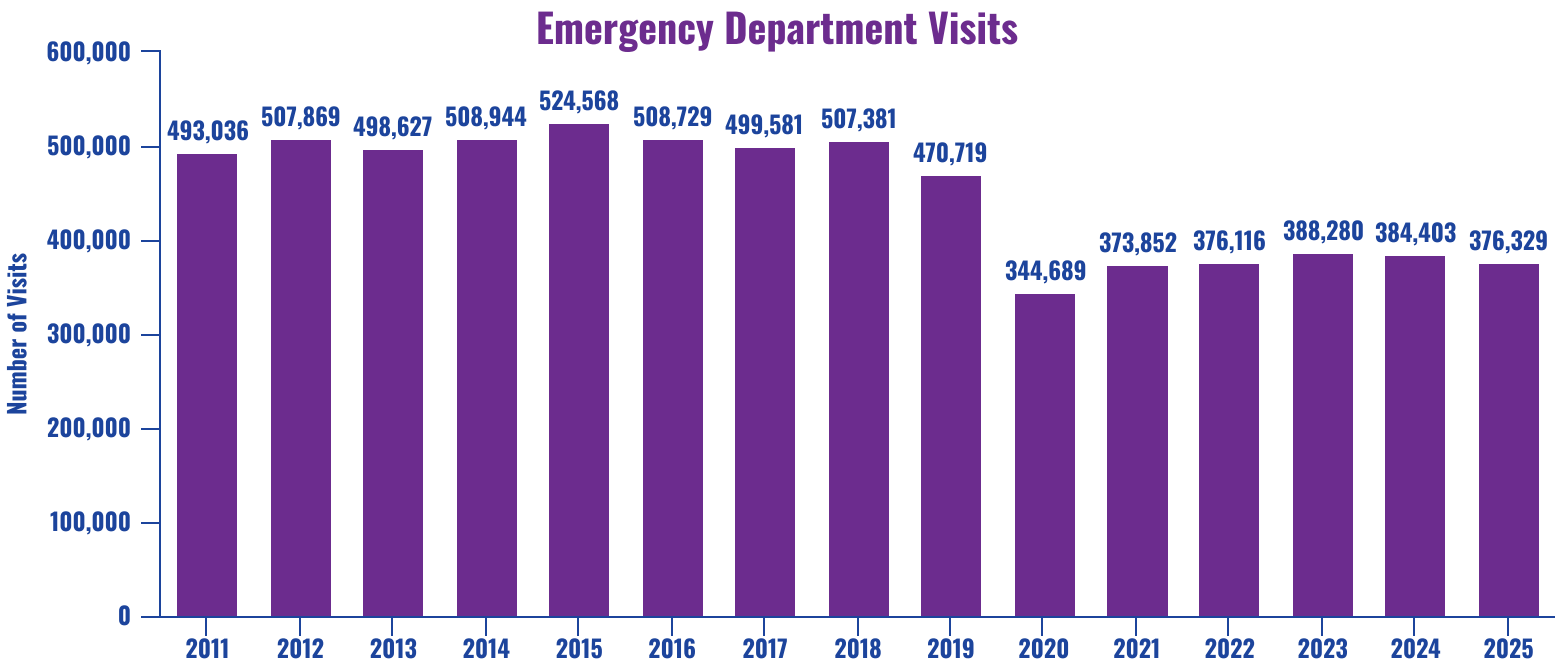

Note: Total ED visits saw a decline in volumes that can primarily be attributed to the closing of United Medical Center in April 2025. Although Cedar Hill Regional Medical Center opened at the same time as UMC's closure, their ED volumes are already comparable to UMC's while Children's National Hospital (CNH) ED at Cedar Hill is slowing making up for CNH's ED volumes at UMC with 8,052 visits from April to December 2025.



Note: Calculations are based on reported utilization figures for the District of Columbia acute non-federal hospitals. The decrease in ED visits in 2019 is primarily related to the closure of Providence Hospital and their associated ED, and the decrease in 2020 is primarily attributed to the impact of COVID-19. Although volumes in 2021 to 2023 continued to rise as the impact of COVID-19 is starting to wane, a slight decline is observed in 2024 and overall volumes remain below the pre-COVID-19 levels. Total volumes decreased even further in 2025 and this can be attributed to the closure of United Medical Center in April 2025.

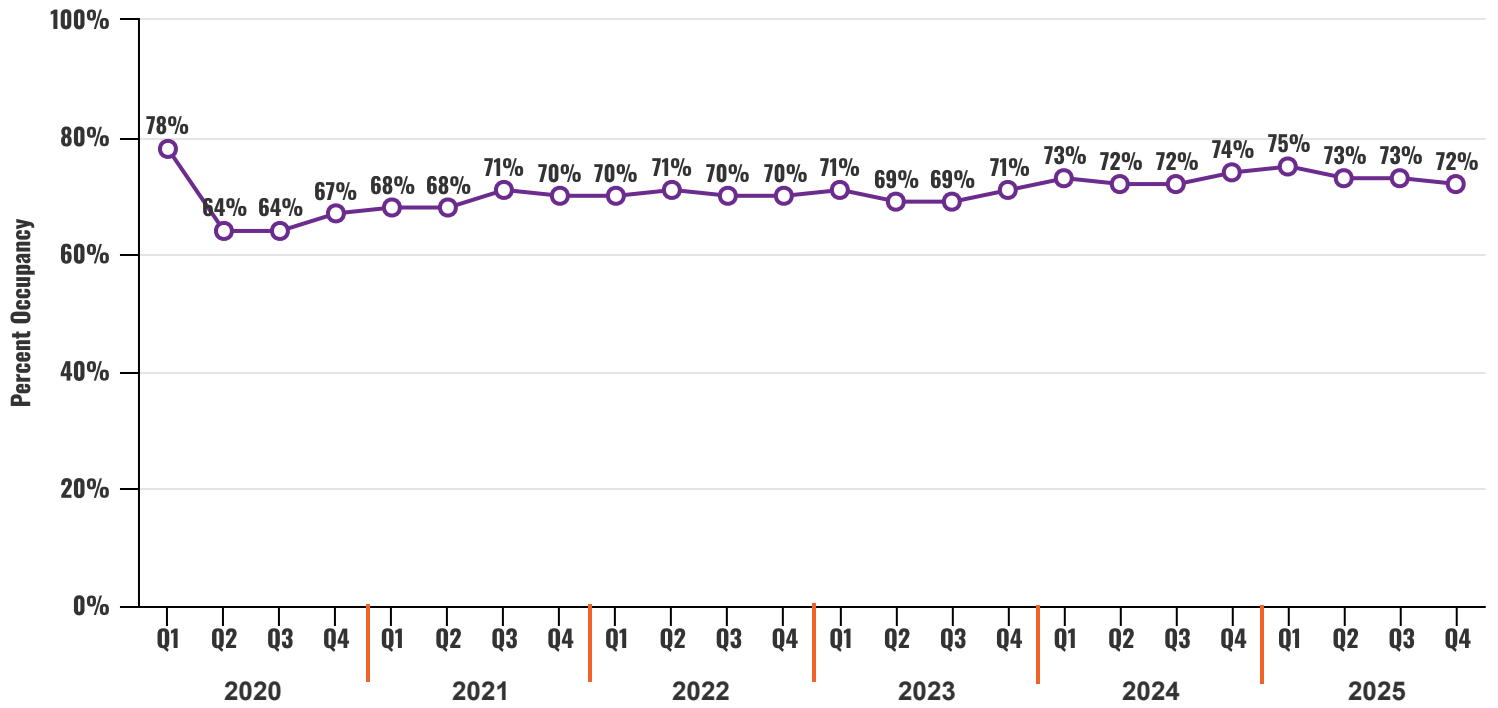
